Historical sign update	 Original draft from Public Archives/Historical Signs was generic and without consideration for Ardencroft's founding as related to cultural changes Including two alternatives provided: Ardencroft incorporated in 1950 as a leasehold community, "sister" to land trusts Arden (1900) and Ardentown (1922). Distinguished by the premise of Founder, Don Stephens: "'You Are Welcome Hither,' for here in Ardencroft we do not ask about a man's religion nor his belief nor do we hold any theory of racial superiority." Newspapers at the time heralded. "Racial Restrictions Waived in New Single Tax Village." Several minority families moved into Ardencroft soon thereafter. In response, Claymont H.S. admitted their children in 1952, before the 1954 Brown v Board decision desegregating public schools. Founded in 1950 as a non-profit corporation, Ardencroft is a leasehold community, "sister" to land trusts Arden (1900) and Ardentown (1922). Uniquely, Ardencroft was established seeking religious and racial integration in co-founder Don Stephen's words: "You Are 	Follow for updates and will consider sign efforts separate from any summertime event due to timeline issues

Newspapers then heralded: "Racial Restrictions Waived in New Single Tax Village." As minority families moved into Ardencroft, children here helped desegregate Claymont High School in 19520, two years prior to nationwide Brown v Board of Education in 1954 Sign creation will take 8-9 months, plus the time it takes for placement.
