Event planning

Significant process related to event planning brainstorm as listed below:

- Single event with 2 parts PAYP dedication at park itself followed by speakers/reception @ Buzz
- Date: late September, early October, checking Buzz for availability (preference of 09/27 followed by 10/04)
- Some logistics to consider include: food/drinks for reception, possibility for music during reception, audio for dedication at the park, 75th anniversary t-shirt using other Ardencroft design, photographer for occasion, public representatives to attend
- A possible flow could include the following:
 - Starting at the PAYP for the Public Works sign unveil and a dedication – include a speaker for brief comments on Pauline A. Young
 - Speakers and panel at Buzz for reception; need to balance PAYP dedication with Ardencroft 75th Anniversary celebration
 - Can consider supplementing speakers or displaying old maps/photos of Ardencroft depending on what's available (example: https://pastmaps.com/ map/marcus-hook-del aware-county-pa-usg s-topo-1953-p1956)
