February minutes were approved.

Existing business

- 75th anniversary open items were discussed. All have been completed except for the trash corrals at both parks. We planned to complete these by June 30, the cutoff date for use of our ORPT funding, but there is some question if that funding has been spent. CR to inquire with the Treasurer.
- Reviews of the work have been very positive. One thing PWC plans to do this summer is apply a walnut stain to the handrail portions of the new Curtis Bridge to settle it into its surroundings a bit more. The decking surface will remain natural since it will be power-washed periodically.
- Dead ash trees are being removed. The work by Perkins Run is complete and firewood is available for residents to cut and split. We are getting the ones by Orchard Walk scheduled imminently.
- The area of runoff concern at Beech Lane was quoted for repair, and PWC will give the go-ahead to begin in next fiscal year's budget.

New Business

- There's a large patch of poison ivy along Sanctuary Path. We are asking our mowing service to spray it.
